Duties & Responsibilities

- Assists in the surgical suite including first assist, deep and superficial wound closure, application of internal devices and any other procedures delegated by the supervising orthopaedic surgeon
- Performs pre-operative and post-operative care in clinics
- Performs comprehensive and problem-focused histories and physical examinations
- Interprets laboratory and diagnostic tests in clinics
- Formulates a treatment plan for orthopaedic conditions within their scope of practice
- Exercises judgment on conditions requiring consultation, referral or evaluation by the supervising orthopaedic surgeon or other health care professionals
- Orders, collects and performs appropriate laboratory and diagnostic studies, such as routine laboratory tests, EMG, electrocardiogram and radiologic examinations including arthrogram, ultrasound, CT, MRI and bone scan studies
- Performs diagnostic and therapeutic procedures such as aspirations and injections of joints, bursars and cysts.
- Applies braces, casts, splints and other orthopaedic appliances
- Conducts hospital rounds, writes orders, takes call and sees patients in the ED for the orthopaedic surgeon if needed
- Average week consists of 4-10's consisting of working in clinics and first assist in operating room and taking ER call
